


GOOD AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES ARE CONSIDERED ONE OF THE FOUNDATIONS OF SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE BECAUSE ONLY THROUGH THEM FARMERS CAN PRESERVE NATURAL RESOURCES FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS. SAFETY IN THE PRODUCTION OF OUR CONSUMPTION FOOD SHOULD BE A CONSTANT CONCERN.

GOOD ACRIGULTURAL PRACTICES ARE:

- TO CONTROL CONTAMINANTS FROM AIR, SOIL, WATER, SUCH AS: FERTILIZERS, AGROCHEMICALS, ANTIBIOTICS OR ANY AGRICULTURAL INPUTS.
 - TO CONTROL PLANTS' HEALTH BY PRACTICES THAT DON'T REPRESENT A DANGER TO HUMAN HEALTH OR THAT AFFECT THE QUALITY AND ADEQUACY OF FOOD.
- TO AVOID THE USE OF AREAS WHERE THE ENVIRONMENT PRESENTS RISKS TO THE SAFETY OF THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT.
 - TO ADOPT PRACTICES TO ENSURE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION UNDER APPROPRIATE HYGIENE CONDITIONS.
 - TO PROTECT FOOD SOURCES FROM FECAL ORIGIN'S CONTAMINATION AND OTHER HARMFUL SOURCES TO HEALTH.
